Onset & rime blending- town /t// own/

Onset rime segmentation- sat /s//at/

Phoneme Isolation- recognizes beginning, middle, and ending sounds of spoken words

Ex. Sally; misty; toss;

Phoneme Blending: ex-pig /p//i//g/

Phoneme Segmentation: ex- dog /d//o//g/

Phoneme Manipulation- manipulate words, giving the new beginning sounds

Ex. Loon-soon
